## How to Turn Your DSP Paper Scraps Into a Beautiful Card

### Measurements:

- Basic White or colored cardstock card base: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" (scored at 4 1/4" and folded)
- Basic White cardstock (3): 5 1/4" x 4"
- \*6 strips of scrap DSP 7/8" wide (inside DSP is 7/8" x 4")

\*This card can be made with any width or length of DSP. The above measurements are for the exact card in the photo.

Note: if you don't have the dies, you can just cut two rectangles measuring 2" x 3" and 2 3/4" x 1 1/2"
