





How to Cut 2 Card Bases FAST Blog Post July 24, 2021



CUTTING & SCORING MEASUREMENTS:

For an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " card base:

- Short side at top of Paper Trimmer
- Score at 4 1/4"
- Cut at 5 ½"

For an 11" x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " card base:

- Long side at top of Paper Trimmer
- Score at 5 ½"
- Cut at 4 1/4"

INSTRUCTIONS: Click here for video

For an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " card base: Orient your 8 1/2" x 11" paper vertically in the Paper Trimmer.

Line up the left edge at the 4 1/4" mark. Score.

Rotate your paper 90 degrees and line it up at the 5 1/2" mark. Cut.

BAM! 2 card bases!

For an 11" x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " card base: Orient your 8 1/2" x 11" paper horizontally in the Paper Trimmer.

Line up the left edge at the 5 1/2" mark. Score.

Rotate your paper 90 degrees and line it up at the 4 1/4" mark. Cut.

BAM! 2 card bases!
